She is excited to announce the Rotary district conference in Reno, NV this year at the Grand Casino Resort. Pam owns two mortuaries and Brian owns a computer shop. Shared her story of her dad being in Rotary when she was growing up, talked about being involved in a lot of Rotary events.
